

**Population by Education**  
 In the current year, the educational attainment of the population aged 25 years or older in the area was distributed as follows:  
 11.8 percent had not earned a high school diploma (14.8 percent in the U.S.)  
 41.3 percent were high school graduates only (29.6 percent in the U.S.)  
 9.9 percent had completed an Associate degree (7.7 percent in the U.S.)  
 11.3 percent had a Bachelor's degree (17.7 percent in the U.S.)  
 6.4 percent had earned a Master's/Professional/Doctorate Degree (10.4 percent in the U.S.)

**Population by Employment**  
 Currently, 87.5 percent of the civilian labor force in the identified area is employed and 12.5 percent are unemployed. In comparison, 89.2 percent of the U.S. civilian labor force is employed, and 10.8 percent are unemployed. In five years the rate of employment in the area will be 89.9 percent of the civilian labor force, and unemployment will be 10.1 percent. The percentage of the U.S. civilian labor force that will be employed in five years is 91.2 percent, and 8.8 percent will be unemployed. In 2000, 66.5 percent of the population aged 16 years or older in the area participated in the labor force, and 0.0 percent were in the Armed Forces.

In the current year, the occupational distribution of the employed population is:  
 11.8 percent in white collar jobs (compared to 61.6 percent of the U.S. employment)  
 41.3 percent in service jobs (compared to 17.3 percent of U.S. employment)  
 9.9 percent in blue collar jobs (compared to 21.1 percent of U.S. employment)  
 In 2000, 84.1 percent of the area population drove alone to work, and 2.6 percent worked at home. The average travel time to work in 2000 was 20.2 minutes in the area, compared to the U.S. average of 25.5 minutes.

**Households by Income**  
 Current median household income is \$50,980 in the area, compared to \$54,442 for all U.S. households. Median household income is projected to be \$56,470 in five years. In 2000, median household income was \$40,753, compared to \$30,103 in 1990.

Current average household income is \$58,347 in this area, compared to \$70,173 for all U.S. households. Average household income is projected to be \$64,886 in five years. In 2000, average household income was \$48,529, compared to \$34,645 in 1990.

Current per capita income is \$22,984 in the area, compared to the U.S. per capita income of \$26,739. The per capita income is projected to be \$25,731 in five years. In 2000, the per capita income was

\$18,647, compared to \$12,528 in 1990.
